Sign up for Health Insurance NOW!

You mean there's a DEADLINE?

Yes! You have just 30 days from your first day of employment to sign up for health insurance benefits. (That's 30 calendar days, not work days). Keep in mind: your first day of employment is the first day listed by your department to UW Payroll, not necessarily the first day you teach.

What happens if I miss the deadline?

If you miss the deadline, you CANNOT sign up for health insurance until you've had a 30-day break in employment (e.g., no UW employment over the summer). This is Wisconsin state law - there are no exceptions!
